stracciatella (soup) Roman egg-drop soup; beaten eggs and cheese are poured into hot broth, forming delicate, shredded strands

made of shredded fresh mozzarella mixed with cream, commonly used as the filling for burrata

stracciatella (gelato) vanilla gelato with thin, irregular chocolate flakes formed by pouring melted chocolate into the cold gelato
